Schedule: As needed.

One of the many ways that Save the Horses raises money to help the horses it saves from abuse and starvation is by holding birthday parties for children. The parties are two hours in length and held under a covered pavilion. We will recruit volunteers to help.

We're looking for a Coordinator with an upbeat personality and a positive attitude for this position. You will liaise with parents and set up party specifics such as dates and times. Some horse experience preferred, but we will train a person that demonstrates commitment and dedication to helping children & animals.

Regular Duties:

- Set up picnic area with tablecloth and some decorations.
- Grooming or painting horses
- Organizing pony rides - Help children on/off horse - Walk the horse.
- Monitor/supervise children as they paint horses (help children apply paint to their hands and paint the horse.)
- Monitor/supervise children at the petting zoo
- Clean up before & after the party
- Put tack, decorations & tablecloth away

Job Requirements:

- Must be at least 21 years of age
- At least six months of volunteering at Save the Horses
- Good physical condition and able to lift 50 pounds.
- Work well communicating and motivating a group of people.
- Attend a new volunteer orientation at Save the Horses
